

Certificate IV in Training and Assessment – Dive Instructors

Course description (TAE40110)

The Certificate IV in Training and Assessment TAE40110 is a nationally recognised qualification that specifies the competencies required to plan, develop, deliver and assess training. All registered training organisations (such as TAFE) and some workplaces require these competencies for you to work with them.



Candidates generally undertake this qualification because they possess vocational competence in a specific industry/subject/technical area and they need to develop or extend competence in training and assessment to facilitate and assess the learning of other individuals.

Who should study the training and assessment qualification?

- Dive Instructors who facilitate First Aid training or other accredited courses
- Those wanting to achieve new skills and recognised qualifications in training and assessing
- Those for whom training and assessing is a main part of their work role
- Those who want nationally recognised training and assessing qualifications

Program overview TAE40110 for Dive Instructors

The Training and Assessment qualification consists of TEN (10) units of competence including seven core units and three elective units. This course has been specifically designed to take into consideration your previous learning and current skills so you can **FAST TRACK** this qualification. If you meet the documentation requirements below you will receive Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for three of the ten units of competency.

To meet the entry requirements of this course and be eligible for RPL for 3 of the 10 units for the TAE40110, you will need to provide the following evidence:

- Certified copy of your Dive Instructor qualification
- Current resume with contact details for referees to support your diver/trainer experience
- A Statutory Declaration (which is provided in your course material), signed off by your dive industry manager or supervisor, to verify your ability at meeting specific criteria.

This program is delivered online allowing you to log in and work through your course at a time and place suitable to your needs

Course fees

Course Duration & Enrolment Period

We suggest that each unit will take approximately 20 hours to complete. This is a very generous estimate that also depends on your previous experience and current skills and knowledge.

Trainer support

You have one-on-one trainer support for the duration of your enrolment. Description of units to be completed

If you meet the entry requirements of the Dive Instructors course, you will only need to complete the following 7 units to achieve the full qualification: Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40110). This has been developed into the following 4 lessons:

TRAINING PACKAGES

- **TAEDES402A - Use Training Packages & accredited courses to meet client needs**
This unit addresses the skills and knowledge required to use Training Packages and accredited courses. This includes identifying and sourcing Training Packages and accredited courses to meet client needs, and interpreting the requirements of Training Package/s including the competency standards/units, the packaging rules for qualifications and the assessment guidelines.

VET LEARNING PROGRAMS

- **TAEDEL401A - Plan, organise and deliver group-based learning**
This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan, organise and deliver training for individuals within a group. It encompasses interpreting the learning environment and delivery requirements for the identified group of learners, developing session plans, and preparing and organising the resources required.
- **TAEDES401A - Design and develop learning programs**
This unit specifies the competency required to conceptualise, design, develop and evaluate learning programs to meet an identified need for a group of learners, using appropriate criteria. Criteria may include endorsed competency standards and other specifications such as organisational performance standards, product equipment specifications and workplace procedures.

PLAN AND ASSESS COMPETENCE

- **TAEASS401B - Plan assessment activities and processes**
This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan and organise the assessment process, including recognition of prior learning (RPL), in a competency based assessment system. It also includes the development of simple assessment plans and instruments.
- **TAEASS402B - Assess competence**
This unit addresses the skills and knowledge required to assess the competence of a candidate.
- **TAEASS301B: Contribute to assessment**
This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to contribute to the assessment process.

ASSESSMENT VALIDATION

- **TAEASS403B - Participate in assessment validation**
This unit specifies the competence required to participate in an assessment validation process.

- Recognition of Prior Learning for any of the remaining units
- Assessment only: Simply work through the assessments
