

Certificate IV in Training and Assessment - Teachers Fast Track

Course description (TAE40110)

The Certificate IV in Training and Assessment TAE40110 is a nationally recognised qualification that specifies the competencies required to plan, develop, deliver and assess training. All registered training organisations (such as TAFE) and some workplaces require these competencies for you to work with them.

Candidates generally undertake this qualification because they possess vocational competence in a specific industry/subject/technical area and they need to develop or extend competence in training and assessment to facilitate and assess the learning of other individuals.



Who should study the training and assessment qualification?

- Those wanting to achieve new skills and recognised qualifications in training and assessing
- Those who hold a Certificate IV in Assessment and workplace training BSZ40198 and wish to upgrade
- Those for whom training and assessing is a main part of their work role
- Those who want nationally recognised training and assessing qualifications
- Secondary teachers who teach VET subjects in schools

Program overview Teachers Fast Track

The Training and Assessment qualification consists of ten (10) units of competence inclusive of seven (7) core and three (3) elective units. If you are a registered Secondary School Teacher and meet the following eligibility requirements you can achieve recognition of prior learning (RPL) for 5 of the 10 units required for this qualification. Now that is a “FAST TRACK!”

Eligibility Requirements

To meet the entry requirements of the Teachers Fast Track and credit transfer for 5 of the 10 units for the TAE40110, you will need to provide the following evidence:

- Certified copy of your Bachelor of Education or Graduate Diploma of Education (or equivalence)
- Passed 1st year probationary period as a practicing teacher
- Your resume' or confirmation of your teaching history and background
- Arrange to have your principal sign a Statutory Declaration (which is provided in your course material), to confirm your ability to conduct workplace training and maintain and support learning relationships.

Course fees

Program fees includes access to your course content which includes all required resources as well as one-on-one trainer support for the duration of your enrolment. Payment can be made via our payment gateways by credit card, bank transfer, cheque or money order. Payment plans are also available by arrangement.

Course Duration & Enrolment Period

Trainer support

Description of units: TAE40110 Teachers Fast Track

If you meet the entry requirements of the Teachers Fast Track, you will only need to complete the following 5 units to achieve the full qualification: Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40110). These units have been developed into the following 3 online lessons.

Training Packages

- **TAEDES402A - Use Training Packages & accredited courses to meet client needs**
This unit addresses the skills and knowledge required to use Training Packages and accredited courses. This includes identifying and sourcing Training Packages and accredited courses to meet client needs, and interpreting the requirements of Training Package/s including the competency standards/units, the packaging rules for qualifications and the assessment guidelines. This unit also includes your understanding of VET 'speak' and processes.

Plan assessment and assess competence

- **TAEASS301B: Contribute to assessment**
This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to contribute to the assessment process.
- **TAEASS401B - Plan assessment activities and processes**
This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan and organise the assessment process, including recognition of prior learning (RPL), in a competency based assessment system. It also includes the development of simple assessment plans and instruments.
- **TAEASS402B - Assess competence**
This unit addresses the skills and knowledge required to assess the competence of a candidate, including an RPL assessment.

Assessment Validation

- **TAEASS403B - Participate in assessment validation**
This unit specifies the competence required to participate in an assessment validation process.

Assessment Pathway

The following pathways are available for you:

- Study followed by assessment
- Recognition of Prior Learning: If you have previous skill and knowledge and can provide evidence to support your RPL application for any of the remaining units. RPL application kit provided on request.
- Assessment only: Simply work through the assessments
